Manly DeLoach "Pee Wee" Padgett



Pee Wee Padgett was born in Edgefield, SC on September 28, 1927. He served in the Merchant Marines from April 30, 1945 to January 20, 1947. After attending basic training in St. Petersburg, FL he served as an Oiler aboard the SS Vicksburg in the Pacific theater during World War II. The SS Vicksburg was a T2-SE-A1 class vessel that supplied oil to US Navy ships in the Pacific Theater. After being discharged from the Merchant Marines in Charleston, SC he returned to Edgefield working as a Postmaster. Pee Wee has been a member of Post 30 for 33 years and is our last surviving World War II veteran.
