Legionnaire of the Quarter



Lawrence E. "JoJo" Doolittle was born on April 22, 1932. A week after graduating from Edgefield High School he was inducted in the Army. After completing 16 weeks of basic and combat training at Ft. Jackson, SC he was sent to Germany. This was at the height of the Korean War and JoJo felt lucky to be sent to Germany because others in his training class were sent to Korea. While in Germany JoJo was in the 8th, 9th, and 28th Infantry Divisions. JoJo served in the Army from July 8, 1953 to May 16, 1955, rose to the rank of Corporal, and was awarded the National Defense Service Medal, Occupation Medal (Germany), and the Good Conduct Medal. JoJo returned to Edgefield after being discharged and worked in the dry wall supply business. He has been a member of Post 30 for 40 Years.
